



CONTACT LENS AGREEMENT

All patients interested in contact lenses are required to have an annual comprehensive eye examination. If your eyes are healthy and we feel you are a good candidate for contact lenses, at your request we will proceed with a contact lens evaluation and fitting.

We fit all types of contact lenses and use only the best quality products available. Our fees include: measuring the shape and curve of your eyes, calculating the appropriate diameter, thickness and power for your contacts, the doctor's expertise in determining the most suitable material and type of contact for your eyes, any diagnostic testing necessary to evaluate the fit of the lenses on your eyes, any diagnostic lenses used, training on proper lens care, a care kit, and any follow-up care required for up to 60 days after your fitting. The price of your contacts will depend on your need and desires. We will tell you exactly what your care and contact lenses will cost when we know what you want and what type of lenses will work best for you.

The Doctor will do her best in determining which contact lenses are suitable for you. However, if it is determined that you are unable to tolerate contact lenses, you will still be responsible for the fitting fee.

AN ANNUAL EYE EXAM DOES NOT INCLUDE A CONTACT LENS EVALUATION

The fees for your contact lens prescription include the use of our office, staff time, the time and expertise provided by the Doctor and the cost of any diagnostic lenses and supplies used. Our fees for a contact lens evaluation and prescription only are listed below. **If you wish to leave our office with diagnostic lenses today, the fees listed below must be paid today.** If you have any questions, please feel free to ask any staff member or the Doctor.
